Across Huntingdonshire, there was a surge of community spirit which led to people coming forwards to volunteer

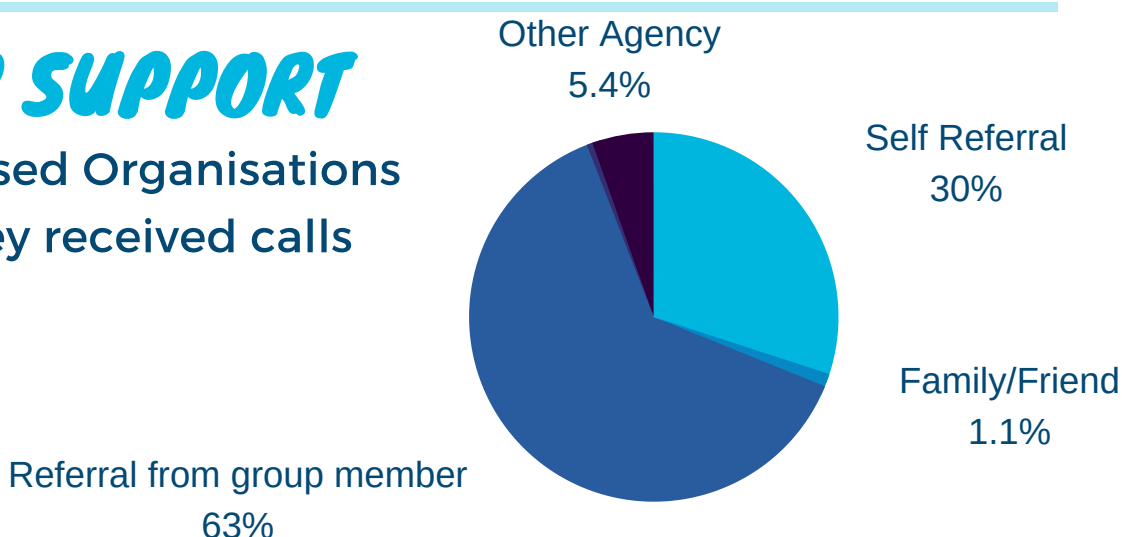
